### Historia Ecclesiastica **NEW**

1801 | 6–12 April | a 7-day tour of Gloucester, Hereford & Worcester cathedrals and their neighbouring churches, from Saxon times to the present day

### Cornwall & Bath

1802 | 17–24 April | an 8-day garden tour of Cornwall, including Lost Gardens of Heligan, Eden Project & two nights and a free day in the historic city of Bath

### Early Spring in East Anglia

1803 | 28 April–3 May | a 6-day spring garden tour of Essex & Suffolk, including Beth Chatto, Helmingham Hall, RHS Garden Hyde Hall and Somerleyton Hall

### Highlands & Islands of Scotland – the west coast (**NEW DATES**)

1804 | 8–15 May | an 8-day scenic tour of Scotland's stunning west coast, including Isle of Skye, Inverewe Gardens, Arduaine, Inveraray Castle and Crae

### Chelsea Flower Show

1805 | 20–28 May | a 9-day, two-centre flower show & garden tour including Members' Only day at Chelsea, Kew, Sissinghurst, Great Dixter & Hever Castle

### A private tour of Kentish gardens

1806 | 21–26 May | a 6-day private tour of the gardens of Kent and East Sussex

### Roses on the English & Welsh Marches **NEW**

1807 | 1–7 June | a 7-day garden tour, concentrating on rose gardens, including David Austin Roses, Powis Castle, Cholmondeley Castle and Old Woollerton Hall

### The Cotswolds & Oxford

1808 | 12–18 June | a 7-day scenic garden tour of the Cotswolds, including Upton Wold, Hidcote Manor, Kiftsgate Court, Waterperry Gardens & free day in Oxford

### The English Lakes

1809 | 22–28 June | a 7-day scenic garden tour of the English Lake District, including Wordsworth's Dove Cottage, Dalemain, Lowther & Ruskin's Brantwood

### The Borders (**NEW DATES**)

1810 | 3–9 July | a 7-day garden tour of the Scottish & English borders, including Lindisfarne, Hadrian's Wall, Kailzie Gardens, Alwick Castle & Gardens and more

### Highlands & Islands of Scotland – the far north & Orkney (**NEW DATES**)

1811 | 12–20 July | a 9-day high-summer tour of the far north of Scotland, including Dunrobin Castle, a day on Orkney, Dunbeath Castle & Inverewe Gardens

### Devon gardens & Dartmoor walks

1812 | 4–10 September | a 7-day garden with walking tour set in the heart of Dartmoor, including RHS Rosemoor, Dartington Hall, Garden House & Cotehele

### Grand Houses, Ancient Stones & a few gardens **NEW**

1813 | 14–20 September | a 7-day tour of the grand houses, history and heritage of Wiltshire and its environs, inc Stonehenge, Stourhead, Salisbury and Avebury

### Early-autumn in Provence

1814 | 26 September–3 October | an 8-day scenic, cultural and sightseeing tour of Provence, especially the Luberon, and its food and wine, inc Aix-en-P and Nîmes
